Birth Certificate Required for all Youth riders

Entry Fee: \$4.00 per class for Non-members

Awards for each age group will be presented September 6, 2008 after the first event.

5th Place	Monogrammed Bronc Halter

Lead Line	- Each qualifying rider will receive a participation award

GENERAL RULES:

- Contestants must ride at least two events each night in 8 of the 11 shows (weather permitting) to qualify for awards.**
- Points will be kept on a one horse / one rider team per night.**
In the event of a tie for High Point or Runner-up, the following sequence will be used to determine placing: the contestant who rode in the most events, the contestant with the most first place awards, then the most second place awards, and so on. If a tie still exists, there will be a run off (according to SRRC rules). There will be no duplicate awards.
- A five second penalty will be added for a pole or barrel knocked down in Poles, Barrels or Straight-Away barrels. Any other knockdowns will result in a **NO-TIME**.
- Age groups - Age as of **June 1, 2008**: Pee Wee - 7 & under; Beginners - 8-11; Juniors - 12-14; Seniors - 15-18; and Adults - 19 and over. You must ride in your own age group.
Birth Certificates Required for Youth riders.
- All qualifying Lead Line riders will receive a participation award at the end of the series. To qualify, the Lead Line rider must participate in at least two of the events each show, and ride in at least 8 of the 11 shows.
- A rider must be signed up to ride before the event starts in their age group. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- An electric timer will be used.
- Suburban Ranches Riding Club rules will be used.



9. No one (except workers) will be allowed in the announcer's stand, on the stairs or in the concession stand. No one is permitted to sit, stand or climb on the arena fences. The property surrounding the arena is private. Trespassing will not be permitted.
10. All contestants must wear full western tack (long pants) and western type boots and/or riding shoes with heels when competing in the arena.
11. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** - Intoxicated persons or profanity will not be permitted.
12. Protests must be in writing and accompanied by a \$100.00 deposit, which will be forfeited if the protest is not sustained. Such protests must state the nature of the complaint and be delivered to the show committee. Their decision will be final.
13. Suburban Ranches Riding Club, its officers, directors and members will not be liable or responsible for damages, losses or accidents to persons, animals or property during or in conjunction with the show.
14. Ribbons for 1st-10th place and High Point awards will be awarded each night in each age group.
15. Awards for the series will be presented at the Suburban Ranches Riding Club, September 6, 2008. SRRC will start at 6:00 pm, with the Award Ceremony following the first event.
16. **Proof of negative Coggins Report required for all horses on SRRC premises.**
